APPENDIX A

MJRWS Water Rates as of July 14, 2021 Updated February 14, 2024

Water rates have a base rate component and a consumption rate component. Each customer is charged a base rate depending on the size of their service meter and a consumption rate based on their monthly water usage.

The base rate for customers is dependent on meter size, also known as equivalent dwelling units or EDUs. The conversion of meter sizes to EDUs is as follows, along with the corresponding monthly base rate.

Commercial/Municipal Customers will be charged a Base Rate that is based on the total number of EDUs to be served in the municipality being served. EDUs are based on the number of each size meter present within the system being served. EDUs are calculated as outlined above and in the water regulations. Consumption rate charges will be based on the average total monthly gallons per EDU with the appropriate consumption rate applied.

Service Call Rates: The minimum service call charge is \$75.00.
